



Transient MKII Digital Audio Converter

Installation Instructions

Windows XP/Windows Vista/Windows 7/Windows 8

For use with PC's using the above operating systems, you will need to download the Windows driver at www.ciaudio.com/transient

To install the driver, unzip the archive and double click the *setup.exe* file, then follow the on-screen instructions.

When the *setup wizard* has completed file installation, the *hardware wizard* will find the new device and ask to connect to Windows Update to search for software. Select "No, not at this time", and click *next*. In the next window, select "Install the software automatically", and click *next*.

Once driver installation is complete, go to the *Control Panel* and select *Sounds/Audio*. Select *CIAudio 2.0* as the audio playback device.

Open your music player software and locate the output settings. Choose *CIAudio ASIO* (or preferred method). The WASAPI option is only compatible with Windows Vista/Windows 7/Windows 8.

If you intend to play high resolution audio files, we recommend using playback software with automatic sample rate detection/switching (Foobar, JRiver, Etc.)

Apple MAC (OS X 10.6.4 or later)

When using Apple MAC models, no drivers are required. Simply connect the Transient MKII via the supplied USB cable.

Go to the *Utilities* folder and select *Audio Midi Setup*. Set the *Output* to *CIAudio USB Audio 2.0*

Next, click the *System Preferences* icon. Under hardware, click the *Sound* icon. Set the *Output* to *CIAudio USB Audio 2.0*

If you intend to play high resolution audio files, we recommend using playback software with automatic sample rate detection/switching (Pure Music, Amarra, Etc.)
